The Noble County Public Library is pleased to announce it will be joining Evergreen Indiana, a consortium of public libraries in Indiana, on March 2, 2009. Founded in conjunction with the Indiana State Library, Evergreen Indiana offers participating Evergreen libraries access to a shared catalog with libraries throughout Indiana (currently 35 libraries and growing!)

What does joining Evergreen Indiana mean for NCPL patrons?

NCPL patrons will have access to materials at any Evergreen Indiana Library that has completed the migration process. Our online catalog will change in appearance, and users will have more opportunities to place holds, browse other libraries' collections, and renew materials at home or on the road.

Sponsored by the Indiana State Library and a Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) grant, this project will save taxpayers money, while simultaneously increasing the available resources for all Library patrons! We are very excited about the next couple of months and the changes they will bring!


